

DETERMINATION OF DESIGN OF FUNDING MECHANISM: COMPETITIVE ALLOCATION PROCESS FOR PROVISION AT LEVELS 1 AND 2 OF THE NEW ZEALAND QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK

Supplementary Determination of Design of Funding Mechanism: Competitive Allocation Process - Maximum Fee

The "Determination of Design of Funding Mechanism: Competitive Allocation Process for Provision at Levels 1 and 2 of the New Zealand Qualifications Framework" was issued in June 2012. The determination establishes a separate funding pool for provision at levels 1 and 2 of the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF), with access to the pool to be managed by the phased introduction of a new competitive allocation process that will allow tertiary education organisations (TEO) to tender for provision.

Paragraph 21 of the funding mechanism stipulates that the maximum fee that may be charged to a student enrolled in provision at level 1 or level 2 of the NZQF for which funding has been allocated via the competitive allocation process, will be specified as a condition to be attached to funding by way of a supplementary determination.

Accordingly, this supplementary determination specifies the maximum fee that may be charged to a student enrolled in provision at level 1 or 2 of the NZQF for which funding has been allocated via the competitive allocation process. It must be read together with and subject to the terms and conditions set out in the "Determination of Design of Funding Mechanism: Competitive Allocation Process for Provision at Levels 1 and 2 of the New Zealand Qualifications Framework".

Maximum Fee

The following condition must be attached to funding provided under the funding mechanism, "Competitive Allocation Process for Provision at Levels 1 and 2 of the New Zealand Qualifications Framework":

A condition that a TEO must not charge any tuition fees or course costs to students enrolled in provision at level 1 or 2 of the New Zealand Qualifications Framework.
