- For people who paid NZ Immigration Service a fee for English lessons before they arrived in NZ
- Lessons in your home
- Qualified teachers

- One - two hours each week
- Lessons in your home
- Learn with a trained, volunteer tutor
- Learn about NZ culture
- For NZ permanent residents
- Free
