The Intensive Literacy and Numeracy Fund - English for Speakers of Other Languages (ILN – ESOL) supports the intensive provision of high quality, fees-free ESOL literacy and numeracy learning opportunities, to help adult refugees (including protected persons) and migrants who are pre-literate learners or learners who have very low levels of English language gain the literacy and numeracy skills needed to progress to further study or the workplace.
